


Biniorella to Cala Monjo

Walk 3

Walking Conditions:

All local walks lie over a variety of surfaced roads, unmade tracks and country footpaths. Whilst walking boots are not essential, the loose, stony and often uneven ground makes sturdy footwear a sensible option. Each itinerary will vary in both duration and terrain with some steep gradients and all require a certain physical effort, especially when it is hot, but they should be well within the scope of an average healthy person.

This route is linear and the instructions start at Biniorella. All distances are approximations and the walking time to the destination is for a moderate walking pace without any lengthy stops. You may return to Biniorella by the same route or alternatively catch a local bus or taxi. Information on local transport timetables is available at reception.

WALK

Leaving *Biniorella* turn left downhill on road. At roundabout turn right signposted to *Camp de Mar* and continue downhill until you come to a left-hand bend, on the corner of which, is a flight of steps leading down to the sea. At the bottom of the steps turn left onto the promenade and follow round until you come to a sundial turnaround. At this point continue along the promenade in front of the *Playa Hotel* and then take the boardwalk, which finishes, by the *La Siesta Restaurant*. Here turn left a short distance uphill until you reach the road. Turn right and continue uphill to the next T-junction. Go right here and follow the road until you come to a fork leading uphill. Take this fork and in 30 meters ascend a steep flight of cement steps on your left.

At the top turn right and ignoring a road to the left continue uphill until you can join a stone paved path alongside a stone wall. Within 50 meters you will come to a gate through a stone-faced wall. Cross the wall leaving a well-made stone boundary wall on your left and continue steeply uphill until you shortly meet a crossway of paths at the brow. Here continue straight ahead and begin to descend until shortly you come to a split in the path you may take either route as they converge a little lower down the hill.

Almost at the bottom of the hill as it begins to level out you will come to a cross track. Go right here and follow the track around until shortly you pass through a sandstone gateway and emerge onto a flat area immediately above *Cala Monjo*. This makes a delightful picnic and swimming spot and access to the water is available either via the stony beach on the right or the boathouse and slipway to your left.

Your return to Biniorella is by the same route.

However if you choose to continue onto *Paguera* via *Cala Fornells* you need to turn right immediately beyond the gateway and follow this access track until you reach *Cala Fornells* and then refer to the last part of the instructions on Walk 4.
