

Montana Cuervo

Walk 12

Distance - 4 km (2½ miles) Ascent: 35m (115ft)

A rare opportunity to visit the inside of a former volcanic crater, as part of an easy, comparatively short, walk. The crater and the lava-covered surroundings provide a most unusual landscape, of interest not only to geologists. This route circumnavigates the mountain on a general level path, good underfoot.

Start/car parking:

Roadside spaces on LZ56, three-quarters of a mile north of the junction with LZ30 or 200 metres north of the administrative boundary marker.

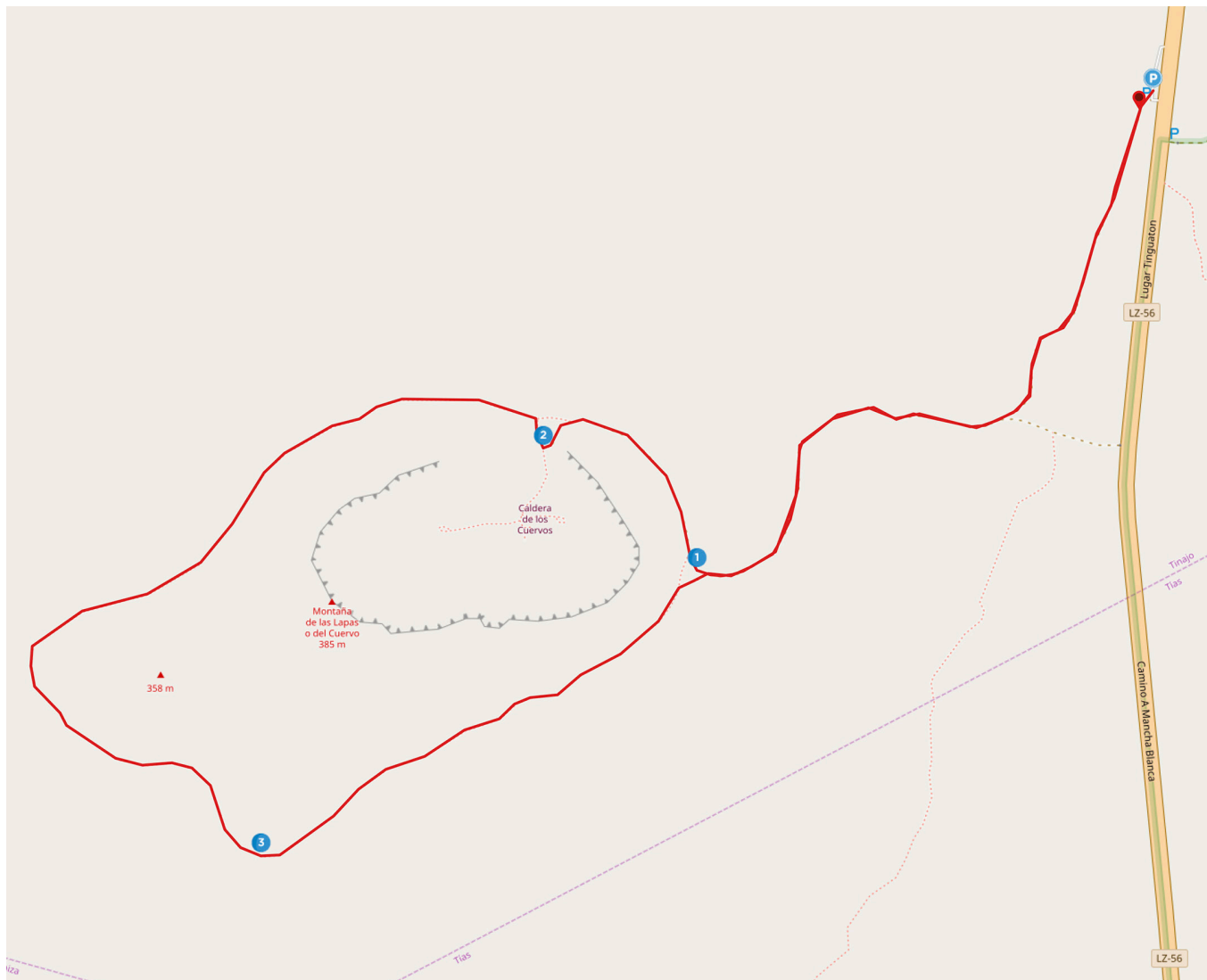
Refreshments:
