

Orgia and the Ethnographic Museum

Walk 9

Distance - 4 km (2¾ miles) **Rise and fall** - 1000ft **Map:** Kompass 666, Siena, Chianti, Colline Senesi, 1:50,000.

An itinerary inside the Ethnographic Museum of Orgia. It is a pleasant excursion which has anthropological, botanical, zoological and landscape interest. A very nice way to know in a dynamic way the reality of the forest and the activities connected to it.

Start/car parking: Orgia: From Stigliano drive in the direction of the main road Siena-Grosseto. Turn right in the direction of Orgia and follow the road. Once you get the first houses of the village, at the crossroads go left following the main road and leave the car at the car parking on the left side just before the village of Orgia.


Refreshments: Restaurant/Cafè "Cateni" (Orgia)

WALK

From the car parking cross the village, below, and go into the wood.

1. The track curves around the podere il Palazzone and goes straight on the main trail.
2. Pass podere San Niccolò and at the Y junction continue on the same path on the left. Continue to go up to the furnace for the production of lime and to the hunting lodge.
3. Follow the trail to meet the farm Fuserna and continue on the main path shaded by large oaks. At the junction, continue on the right along the path n. 403 for the Romitorio stream and a chestnut drier.
4. After a few hundred meters you arrive at the Romitorio farm, visit the farm and at the rear there is the facade of the old little church. From here go back on the main path, that rises slightly and then begins to go down to the intersection with a small path on the right that leads to the farm Casone. Go straight in this path and continuing until the Podere San Niccolò, go left here. Follow this path and arrive at Orgia. Pass through the village (it is possible to stop for a rest or a refreshment in Restaurant "Cateni") and reach the car parking.
